To Councillor Mel Kendal, Cabinet member for Transport, Hampshire County Council:

We call on Hampshire County Council to cancel the proposed deletion of the 35 service which will leave the western parts of Stubbington and Hill Head, with no direct service to Fareham Railway station.

If you feel unable to reprove the 35 at the moment, we ask you to at least persuade First Bus to improve the evening service on the 33. At present, the last 33 leaves Solent Road at 1822 (1622 on Saturdays). This effectively rules out the 33 even for inward journeys for people spending an evening in Fareham.
